

In 1873 ground was broken to begin the building of the St. Peters Cathedral in Erie, Pennsylvania. A slate roof was installed on the steep pitches, along with a standing seam copper roof at lower pitches, and copper gutters set-into the stone perimeter of the roof.

Prior to the re-roof \$2 million in "gold leaf" was applied to the walls and ceilings inside the church. This meant the winter prior to the new roof installation

the existing roof had to be protected. The re-roof began in the Spring of 2023, with the 150-year-old slate being removed first, as Sharkskin Ultra SA® was installed to protect the Cathedral.

Sharkskin Ultra SA® was chosen for the re-roof of the St.





Peters Cathedral, in Erie, Pennsylvania, for its long term 50-year warranty and High-Temp rating under the new Greenstone Slate roof and Standing Seam Copper Roof. In addition, the Cathedral is approximately a little more than a mile from Lake Erie. Lake Erie is known for its strong "lake breeze" winds. The men from A.W. Farrell & Son, Inc., have experience with Sharkskin Ultra SA® and know once installed properly, it's not going to blow off.

In addition, the walking surface of the Sharkskin Ultra SA® provided the men setting the roof scaffolding, and roof jacks with a safe walking surface. The scaffolding set directly on top of the Sharkskin Ultra SA® was leak-free during the roof installation. Sharkskin Ultra SA provided leak-free protection on the entire project from start to finish, as well as providing 12-Month UV Protection.

With the top of the Cathedral steeple at 300' and the distance to the top of the gutters at 80'-100', it was important that the project ran smoothly. Every pallet of slate had to be "ring tested," which means a hammer is used to test the slate, to make

sure there are no cracks. The slate will ping in just the right way to confirm, soundness. In addition, slate was pulled from three separate pallets onto one, to maintain even color dispersion across the roof plane, to eliminate blotches of lighter and darker slates.

The standing seam copper roof panels and copper gutters were fabricated locally by Armor Fab, LLC, owned by Robert Pace. The copper gutters were made in 20' lengths and craned up to the roof. The on-site crane was invaluable for the installation of both the Copper Sheetmetal work and slate roof installation.





Unfortunately, this construction led to issues with condensation and mold. The new owners completely gutted the house and started anew. Renoteck Metal Roofing & Exteriors was commissioned to design and execute the exterior finish.

he biggest challenge with this job: We had to install all the flashing details around the porches and any place were there was sidewall / endwall so the stone mason could do his work first so that he would have worry about damaging the metal roof. Then we would come along after him and install the panels.

We started the project the first week in April 2023 and finished the last of July, only working on it two to three days a week because we had to follow after the mason. Given the pitch of the roof, we had to use lifts and/ or scaffolding almost everywhere.

The customer wanted us to keep moving to not hold up his insulation and drywall crews.  $\blacksquare$ 









ur Lady of Assumption Church was built in 1845. It is the oldest operating church west of Montreal in Canada. The rain water is running into a rainwater harvesting cistern.

The metal panels were finished in Weathered Zinc, a metallic stormy-gray color, to help the project team keep the desired architectural color palette across each of the home's design elements.

Jet Metals roll-formed the remaining coils into the DMC 100SS profile, which was installed across the flat section of the roof directly above the home's outdoor living space. This mechanically seamed metal roof system adds architectural appeal and all-around performance in any type of coastal weather. The metal panels were also finished in Weathered Zinc for design cohesiveness.

ocated just north of Dallas sits the historic and dramatic Fannin County Courthouse. We loved every last minute making the custom historic metal shingles and accessories to match the originals.

Choosing a Colonial Red color for the PVDF paint, our clients




sent over original pieces for us to copy and replicate in Galvalume. We engineered each piece to last and each piece to look just like the original roofing material.

This project was particularly fun, as we got to replicate, engineer and manufacture three different shingle designs:

The first shingle was a flat lock, horizontally running, custom-pressed shingle measuring 6" x 12". This variety covered about 12,000 sq. ft. which

equates to approximately 24,000 pieces!

The courthouse features rounded dormers. To be applied on these areas, we made about 5,000 pieces of 12" x 16" rectangular custompressed shingles.

Finally, and perhaps most dramatically, we manufactured about 5,000 special 7" custom embossed diamond shingles to cover the domes.

This project required two roofing teams for the installation. One for the roof and the other tasked with the tower areas.

As the building is situated in a tornado and other heavy storm zone, we provided custom stainless steel fasteners in engineered quantities to protect against wind uplift.

hen you're running the fastest-growing county in the nation's fastest-growing state, you've got a lot to keep up with when it comes to ensuring local services can keep up with the expanding population. This definitely has been the case for school officials in Florida's St. Johns County, where the population grew by 43% between 2010 and 2020. It seems new schools fill up almost as soon as they open their doors. To speed construction — and ease transitions for students who might get shifted to new facilities as they become available — the county-wide school district has developed model plans for its K-8 and senior high buildings.

The recently completed Pine Island Academy is an example of the K-8 design. Its roofline, which features metal roof panels to highlight entrances, interior stairwells and light wells, illustrates how such decorative touches can help the district's schools develop their own characters, even if they're all built to similar plans.

St. Johns County is in the northeast of Florida, abutting the Jacksonville metropolitan area, and features a lengthy coastline. This location has proved so attractive that more than 83,000 people moved into the area between the last two censuses — and an additional 25,000 joined them in









the past three years. Pine Island Academy now is one of seven similar schools within the county's school district (a number of K-5 and middle schools also serve this age group), which now serves almost 60,000 students in a total of 51 schools.

Located in St. Augustine, the 127,000 sq. ft. school is planned for a capacity of 1,500 students. Designers with the Jacksonville office of Harvard Jolly Architecture followed the template they developed for Palm Valley Academy a few years earlier. While the roof is predominantly low-rise membrane, sloped metal accents help break up the façade and add interest to the roofline. The architects specified Petersen to supply the PAC-CLAD metal roof panels – but the client had the final word when it came to the profile specified for the project.

"The senior project manager for the St. Johns County School District wanted the Snap-Clad Panel," says Earl Drummond, the project manager leading

the installation team from Thorne Metal Systems of Orange Park, Florida. Harvard Jolly's architects initially had selected Petersen's Tite-Loc Plus product - a good choice, given its 180-degree mechanical seam - but the school's project manager thought Snap-Clad would be a better fit, given the panels' visual prominence from street level. "He thought it looked better – we've worked with him a few times and he likes the look of that panel."

Though Drummond says this was a good-sized job for Thorne, it posed few challenges aside from the usual deadline issues common to school projects that need to be wrapped up in time for the next school year's start. He added that familiarity with Petersen as a supplier was a plus in helping ensure his company met the client's expectations. "I love working with Petersen," Drummond says, noting the support Thorne gets from Petersen's local representative, Dave Landis.

he Fahy Commons building at Muhlenberg College in Allentown, Pennsylvania, recently won three major sustainability awards.\* ATAS International manufactured the 24-gauge steel 2" Field-Lok standing seam metal roof panels, 15-1/4" wide, for this building. A solar array consisting of 183 panels was installed over the Sandstone-colored metal roof

Standing seam metal panels are the ideal choice for a rooftop solar system because of their long service life. When installing solar panels (typically warranted for 25 years of power generation), a building owner benefits from a roofing substrate that has a greater life expectancy than the solar panels. The solar panels can be installed to the metal panel seams using special clamps, without any roof penetrations.

Through a generous gift from Gerald P. Fahy (Muhlenberg College class of 1979) and Cathleen A. Fahy, this three-story building was made possible. 
